

# Restrictions Committee Status Report for April

The Restrictions Committee is pleased to report, in this second status report, that we have made real progress on our assignment from the CLPOIA Board: “To recommend to the Board amendments to the current Association Restrictions for the purpose of preparing a public vote.”

We completed our review of 28% of the current restrictions and prepared draft language that will later be submitted to the Board. We examined each paragraph to determine if it still applies, or not. If the paragraph is no longer appropriate, or if it can be improved or if it can be clarified, we prepared language to propose an amendment.

An analysis of our work to date shows that our draft contains about as much language from the original restrictions as from the version proposed last year. Further, a slightly higher fraction of our draft is made up of new language that we wrote in our attempt to simplify and clarify the restrictions.

As we proceed we are working hard to show how each section or subsection has been amended. We also are making notes so we can prepare rationale to explain all proposed amendments to the current restrictions.

As we reported last month, we plan to recommend to the Board that voting be

allowed on major sections or subsections ... rather than requiring a YES/NO vote on the entire document.

An important part of our current work is trying to define a ballot that will be as simple as possible but will allow for voting at more detailed levels.
